

Japan-Russia Cultural Exchange Program

February 5 – February 23, 2018

Kanazawa University

Overview

Japan-Russia Cultural Exchange Program by Kanazawa University is a specially developed program as part of the Inter-University Exchange Project.

This program offers Japanese language classes, lectures on Japanese culture and society, and a factory tour of local companies. Participants will also join a 2-day trip to Gokayama Region of Toyama Prefecture together with Japanese students of Kanazawa University.

Detailed program schedule will be provided after the acceptance notification at the end of December.

Dates

The program lasts for 19 days, from February 5 (Mon.) to February 23 (Fri.), 2018.

Number of Students

Approximately 10 students

Scholarships and Fees

Each participant in this program will receive a scholarship of 80,000 JPY, and will be provided a round-trip ticket to and from Japan arranged by Kanazawa University.

Participants will be responsible for accommodation fees, meals, domestic transportation, and other personal expenses through the program.

Eligibility

Applicants must satisfy all of the following requirements. They must

1. be currently enrolled in the undergraduate or Master's program at universities in Russia,
2. be interested in Japanese culture and language,
3. be proficient in English in order to understand lectures,
4. go back to their home universities and continue their education after finishing the program,
5. be able to obtain appropriate visa status in Japan,
6. be in good health.

Application Procedure

Step 1: Fill out the application form and prepare the additional documents below.

- An official or unofficial transcript from your home institution (PDF format)
- Your ID photo (3cm*4cm) in JPEG or other digital format
- A photocopy of the ID page of your passport (PDF format)

Step 2: Submit the completed application materials to the international office of your home institution. Note that we only accept applications through your home institution. Applications from individual students will not be processed.

Step 3: Your home institution will send the application materials by the following deadline:

Application Deadline: November 30 (Thu), 2017

Notification of Acceptance

Kanazawa University will notify the acceptance to the international office of your home institution by the end of December.

Visa

Depending on his/her nationality, participants in the program may be required to obtain a “Temporary Visit (Tourist)” or “Student” Visa. The procedure for obtaining visa will be notified after the acceptance notification. For more information, please see the link below:
